I have much more extensive notes written from our meetings and exhaustive answers from 6 DSN's specific to training needs and WIB collaboration. However this is a brief recap which I will add to by tomorrow. Alex Davis has done a tremendous job thus far. I have attached a rough draft document that outlines the DSN's input.

The training and sector initiatives sub committee objectives:

1. To identify and remove barriers to training by and with Community Colleges for Workforce Development Boards, including opportunities for direct contracting, ITAs cohort training and ETPL.
2. Support regional planning, coordination and alignment of common sector strategies and career pathways initiatives linked to an in-demand occupations in high growth industry clusters.

Actions Taken:

1. Create a matrix that lists definitions of credit, noncredit, not for credit and contract education within Community Colleges.
2. Develop a graph of priority sectors/key industries of California Dept. of Education CTE model curricula standards, CCCC Doing what matters top 10 sector priorities, 10 primary LAEDC clusters and various WIB priority industries.
3. Contacted LA County Deputy Sectors Navigators and asked their expertise on training needs and how WIBs can collaborate with California Community Colleges.
