There is still no information regarding the terms of the final report but please be on alert that CPS may need to provide information in particular data linked to the previous TOP Codes selected.</li> <li>b. Round 4 Activities – July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2023: A small group of Career Pathway Specialists are working on design and distribution of posters to market Articulation and Dual Enrollment programs to local high schools. For the tag line on bottom of poster, we need a single line at the bottom of poster. Goal is to get these out for spring.</li> <li>c. Round 5 Funding Updates: Pasadena City College, the new fiscal agent, will begin in January 2022.
