IV. K 12 Strong Workforce Program Round 5 – Linda Bermudez, K14 TAP	Linda provided a brief update on K12 SWP. The addition of 4 pathways coordinators is a huge accomplishment. The K12 SWP funding provides for 72 K12 Pathway Coordinators statewide (one per community college district and 8 TAPs.) That translates to only 11 positions for all of LA Co. With the additional funds through the Career Pathways Partnership Project, we have four additional K12 PCs. It is very important to highlight this regional investment and stress the importance of collaboration with the Career Pathways Specialists. The K12 staff are actively involved in Round 5 K12 SWP grants as they close on October 18, 2022. It is critical that we leverage Career Pathways Specialists involvement; creating connections between K12 and the community colleges and potential for buy in with match. Linda encouraged both Career Pathways Specialists and K12 PCs to please reach out for support. She noted that the LARC website has round 5 updates. She stated that this is an exciting time to be in LARC.
